Multiplier Event I

(09.01.2023)

The first multiplier event began with the presentation of the goals and results of the DANTE project. The participants of the meeting got acquainted with the results of a survey conducted among the academic community in five European partner universities, thanks to which barriers and difficulties in communication between students, lecturers, and university administration during online education were identified.

In response to the achieved results of survey studies, the project team has developed guidelines from which it is possible to learn, among other things: how to motivate students to cooperate during distance learning, how to keep the attention of listeners during an online lecture, which personality types need what kind of messages and what influences on the effectiveness of education evaluation. The participants were presented with guidelines prepared in several forms - short films, a pdf document, and posters - infographics.

In the second part of the meeting, asynchronous communication workshops for high school students were held, during which the participants improved their competencies in the correct construction of e-mail correspondence, ways of effectively reaching the recipient with the message, and avoiding language traps.

The first multiplier event ended with collecting feedback from the participants on the workshops and handing out gifts.

At the beginning of the second multiplier event, the general assumptions of the project and its results were presented by the Project Team. The content of the presentation was the same as presented during the multiplier event I.

Afterward, the participants went to a focus group meeting. The subject of discussion was the topics covered in the remote communication guidelines developed by the Project Team.
