Characteristics of doctoral studies

- Graduates of master's degree programmes can apply for admission to doctoral studies.
- The doctoral study lasts 4 years.
- The graduate obtains a PhD.
- It is possible to study in full-time or part-time form of study. It is possible to study in Czech or English.
- The study consists of a **study part** completed by a state doctoral examination and a **scientific-professional part** focused on the elaboration of a dissertation completed by its defense.
- A unified **credit system** is used to evaluate the course of study in the doctoral study programme.

Within the scientific-research preparation, students are trained in subjects including applications of exact methods that enhance the effectiveness of both analytical activities in the company, and the...

Finance

Doctoral study programme Finance follows master degree at Faculty of Economics, especially those of Finance or Finance & Accounting study programmes, though any other master degree is basically sufficient to enter doctoral study programme Finance.

The doctoral studies at Faculty of Economics, VSB-Technical University of Ostrava should take 4 years according to a personal study plan of the student. It specifies all study requirements, such as courses, teaching activities, research activities,...

Systems Engineering and Informatics

Systems Engineering and Informatics (SEI) postgraduate study program follows up several master's study programs at VŠB – TU Ostrava, Faculty of Economics, especially Information and knowledge management. This study program is scheduled for 4 years and graduates are awarded the Ph.D. degree. The program can be studied in several mutations – full-time and part-time, in Czech and in English.



What is the course of doctoral studies?



Publishing activity (articles in journals or papers at conferences)

Pedagogical activity (conducting exercises, testing...)

Participation in grants (SGC, GAČR) as the main researcher or team member

Compulsory internship abroad



How to cover the living costs of full-time study?

Regular monthly scholarship is only for Czech students

Grant monthly scholarship

It can amount to CZK 5 000 - 10 000 depending on the type and size of the grant

Extraordinary scholarship

One-time, which is awarded by the dean either himself or at the proposal of the subject council or the head of the relevant department, after discussion with the supervisor, or also at the request of the student (for example for extraordinary scientific activity, active work, teaching, etc.)

Other student benefits

Doctoral students have the same student benefits as bachelor's or master's students:

- Fare discounts
- Discounts on cultural performances
- Discounts on products
- ISIC card

How does the admission procedure work?

Topic consultation with the supervisor

The selected topic is consulted by the applicant with a supervisor, which he/she chooses from the list of supervisors

Approval of the head of the department

The full-time applicant chooses the department at which he/she wants to perform pedagogical and scientific research activities and obtains the prior approval of the head of the department

Submission of the admission application

The candidate must submit the application for study only electronically by February 29th, 2024 https://prihlaska.vsb.cz/uchazec

Payment of the administrative fee

The administrative fee of CZK 500 must be paid by February 29th, 2024.

A fee for the Assessment of applicants' foreign education as part of the admission procedure at VŠB – TU Ostrava in the amount of CZK 600.

Submission of syllabus

Submission of syllabus of the doctoral dissertation theses by June 6th, 2024 with the recommended structure:

A. Theme and subject

B. Expected definition of dissertation

- Objective and results Structure of work
- Applied methods and methodology
- Structured bibliography

Attachments to the electronic application

Submission of the following documents till March 31st, 2024

- Copies of Document of previous study completed in a Master or equivalent level
- Recognition certificate of previous education February 29th, 2024
- Structured Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of valid travel document
- Language certificate

What is the content of the entrance exam?

Entrance exam

Entrance exam consists of knowledge test from chosen study programme with respect to the topic of dissertation theses.

Entrance examinations take place at the admission committee appointed by the Dean of the Faculty for the given study programme.

The committee will evaluate the individual parts of the examination by a score of 0 to 100. The candidate succeeded if he/she achieved at least 51 points.

•CZK 500 per semester in a doctoral degree programme. Changes are valid from academic year 2022/2023.
