INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS ARRIVING WITHOUT A VALID NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST CARRIED OUT IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC (COUNTRIES NEEDING A COVID-19 TEST FOR ENTRY)

Dear Students

Please read and follow the following instructions carefully:

- once you arrive, please register at the main reception desk in building AB, which is open 24/7
- you will get the keys to a temporarily assigned room building D, 5th floor
- you must undertake a test for COVID-19 in the Czech Republic as soon as possible. Accommodation services have to inform the Regional hygiene station about the result within 72 hours of your arrival.
- those of you arriving without a valid negative test will receive a welcome pack including: reimbursement for the Covid-19 test (the maximum amount of reimbursement is 1 756 CZK), hand sanitizer, cloth face mask, university merchandise, International Contact Point Office services including personal support at meetings, on-campus psychologist, general practitioner, information services and interpretation.
- please inform the reception desk if you had the test already at <u>Prague Airport</u> (reimbursement is also possible, but only for the standard test for 1 756 CZK results done in 24 hours).
- you can undertake the test at <u>Fakultní nemocnice Ostrava-Poruba</u> (hospital near campus), more information can be found <u>HERE</u>
- before going for the test, you have to register <u>HERE</u> (personal identification number is your passport number)
 - testing office is open from 7 am to 3 pm
 - test costs 1 756 CZK and it is possible to pay by credit card
 - if you need any assistance, please contact the <u>International Contact Point Office</u>, e-mail: <u>kamila.pokorna@vsb.cz</u>, <u>kristina.hoblikova@vsb.cz</u>, <u>barbora.stivarova@vsb.cz</u>
 - please keep the receipt of payment for reimbursement
- once you get the test results, you have to bring it to the Accommodation Office, where it will be reimbursed. Then you can move to your assigned room.
- until you know your test results, your free movement will be restricted. You can leave your
 accommodation to travel to purchase food and basic necessities, medications, travel to a doctor,
 travel to school or to attend urgent official matters, or to a post office. Limitation of the free
 movement of persons mainly covers:
 - ✓ restrict your presence in publicly accessible places to the minimum time required
 - ✓ when in contact with others, please maintain a safe distance of at least two meters
 - ✓ do not attend any public events, do not visit restaurants, gyms or fitness centres, etc.
 - √ do not accept visitors in your room
 - ✓ use a face mask to cover your mouth and nose every time you leave the room
- if you have a positive test result, please inform the staff of the Accommodation Office immediately on the phone: +420 596 996 152. You will receive an email with instructions to follow.
- please be aware of the fact that the receptionists will be checking compliance with the rules
